Residential Insight into University

Summer Schools 2023

Insight into University residential courses (previously known as Headstart) are summer schools run over 4 or 5 days where students get a taster of university life and an insight into a specific STEM subject. Students will get the opportunity to experience university style lectures and work on activities and group projects with the support of academics and student mentors. Students will stay in halls of residence and will take part in social activities in the evenings.

These courses are for Year 12/S5-6 students and are a great way to try out a STEM subject at university before applying. This allows students to make a better informed decision for their UCAS application, as well as meeting like-minded students from all over the UK.

These summer schools are run for small groups (on average 30 students) and so places are limited.

Applications open on the 3rd of October 2022 and will close on the 3rd of January 2023.

In light of the 2023 entry Medicine applications closing later this month, our academic departments are looking to encourage and support the next round of future Medics. In addition to this, our Health Sciences department have been working on their opportunities for students interested in pursuing careers in Medicine, Health or Care related fields.

Medicine Virtual Work Experience

Are you interested in gaining work experience in a hospital setting?

The University of Southampton and University Hospital Southampton are offering students in Year 10, 11, 12 and 13 the opportunity to apply for LIVE virtual work experience delivered through Microsoft Teams.

This programme is open to all students however there are places set aside for students who meet 2 or more widening participation criteria.

A typical timetable usually includes:

- Operating Theatre
- Ward Rounds
- Outpatient Clinic
- WISH Lab
- Apprenticeship Opportunities
- Opportunity to speak to current medical students

 Opportunities to speak with a variety of clinicians representing Pharmacology, Health Sciences, Histopathology, Cardiac Physiology and more.

As this is a live programme, it is always subject to change depending on the day-to-day happenings within the hospital. We expect students to treat this experience like a face-to-face work experience placement and students who are late or fail to attend sessions will be removed from the programme. Please ensure you are available for all days before you apply.

Usually, the programme is delivered online between 9am and 4pm. Our next events will be on 25 - 27 October 2022.
